

BYLAW NO. 9 – 2002

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF LLOYDMINSTER IN THE PROVINCES OF SASKATCHEWAN AND ALBERTA TO FURTHER AMEND BYLAW NO. 25-86, AS AMENDED, BEING "THE GARBAGE BYLAW OF THE CITY OF LLOYDMINSTER".

The COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLOYDMINSTER in the Provinces of Saskatchewan and Alberta enacts as follows.

That Bylaw No. 25-86 being "The Garbage Bylaw" is hereby further amended in the manner set forth:

- 1. Deleting Part 10, Section 36, and inserting the following in its place:

Part 10
FEES

- 36 (a). 1. Each single detached, semi-detached, and duplex dwelling in the City of Lloydminster that is connected to the City water system shall be charged a monthly fee of \$7.15 per water meter to defray the cost of providing garbage collection and disposal services.
- 2. Each single detached, semi-detached, and duplex dwelling in the City of Lloydminster that is connected to the City water system shall be charged a monthly fee of \$3.00 per water meter to defray the cost of providing blue box services.
- 3. All other properties not described under Section 36 (a) 2. and are connected to the City water system shall be charged a monthly fee of \$2.00 per water meter to defray the cost of providing blue box services.

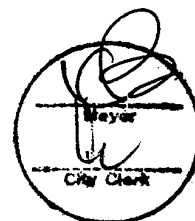
The monthly fee so charged shall be added to and shall form part of the periodic billing for water and sewer service charges as authorized under the current water and sewer bylaw.

- 36 (b) All persons, other than City Residents, hauling their waste originating within City limits that is acceptable to the landfill site shall be assessed a disposal fee as follows:

<u>Material</u>	<u>Disposal Fee Rate</u>
Garbage/Refuse.....	\$ 8.20 per tonne
Shingle/Roofing.....	\$ 6.60 per tonne
Concrete/Asphalt.....	\$ 2.20 per tonne
Straw/Yard/Garden.....	\$10.40 per tonne
Wood Products	\$ 6.00 per tonne
Liquid Waste.....	\$ 4.00 per tonne
Contaminated Soil.....	\$40.00 per tonne
Appliances.....	\$10.00 each

36 (c) All persons, other than City Residents, hauling their waste tires originating within City limits that is acceptable to the landfill site shall be assessed a disposal fee as follows:

<u>Type/size of Tire</u>	<u>Disposal Fee Rate</u>
a) 7" size or less, including wheel barrow, snow blower, petal bike tires.....	Nil
b) 8" to 19.5:" - passenger, light truck, small agriculture, lawn & garden equipment, any tire of equal size/weight	\$ 5.00 each
c) 20" to 24.5" -- semi-medium truck, implement, any tire of equal size/weight\$10.00 each
d) 24" to 50" - agriculture (rear ag), grader, any tire of equal size/weight	\$20.00 each
e) 20.5' to 25" and up – off the road, mining, forestry, earth moving, any tire of equal size/weight	\$50.00 each

36 (d) Notwithstanding those fees shown under 36 (b) all persons hauling waste originating within City limits that is acceptable to the landfill site shall be assessed a minimum disposal fee as follows:

Minimum charge for Cash Customers \$ 3.00 per load
Minimum charge for Charge Customers \$ 5.00 per load

36 (e) All persons hauling waste originating from outside City limits that is acceptable to the landfill site shall be assessed a disposal fee as follows:

a) Disposal Fee..... \$ 70.00 per tonne
Minimum charge for Cash Customers..... \$ 6.00 per trip
Minimum charge for Charge Customers..... \$ 10.00 per trip

b) Tires – as per 36 (c)

2. This Bylaw shall repeal Bylaw No. 10-96, Bylaw No. 6 – 99, Bylaw No. 29-99, Bylaw No. 32-99, Bylaw No. 24-2000 and Bylaw No. 30-2001.

3. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on March 1, 2002.
