

BYLAW NO. 11 – 2007

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF  
LLOYDMINSTER IN THE PROVINCES  
OF SASKATCHEWAN AND ALBERTA  
TO FURTHER AMEND BYLAW  
NO. 25-86, AS AMENDED, BEING  
"THE GARBAGE BYLAW OF THE CITY  
OF LLOYDMINSTER".

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The COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLOYDMINSTER in the Provinces of  
Saskatchewan and Alberta enacts as follows.

That Bylaw No. 25-86 being "The Garbage Bylaw of the City of Lloydminster" is  
hereby further amended in the manner set forth:

1. Part 10, Section 36 FEES is deleted, and the following is inserted in its place:

Part 10  
FEES

- 36(a) 1. Each single detached, semi-detached, and duplex dwelling in the City of  
Lloydminster that is connected to the City water system shall be charged  
a monthly fee of \$11.00 per water meter to defray the cost of providing  
garbage collection and disposal services.
2. Each single detached, semi-detached, and duplex dwelling in the City of  
Lloydminster that is connected to the City water system shall be charged  
a monthly fee of \$3.00 per water meter to defray the cost of providing  
recycling and blue box services.
3. All other properties not described under Section 36(a) 2. and are  
connected to the City water system shall be charged a monthly fee of  
\$2.00 per water meter to defray the cost of providing recycling and blue  
box services.

The monthly fee so charged shall be added to and shall form part of the  
periodic billing for water and sewer service charges as authorized under  
the current water and sewer bylaw.

- 36(b) 1. All persons, other than those specified in Section 36 (b) (i), hauling  
waste originating within City limits that is acceptable to the landfill  
site shall be assessed a disposal fee as follows:



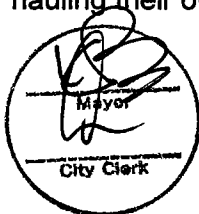

**Schedule A:** Applies to any In-City Business. Must provide proof of a valid City Business Licence.

**Schedule B:** Applies to any waste (residential, commercial or industrial) originating outside City limits.

**Schedule C:** Applies to any In-City Resident. Must provide proof of residency with a valid driver's licence.

36(b)(i) Notwithstanding the foregoing, a resident of the City shall not be subject to the fees listed in 36(b) excepting appliances, tires and used glycol, if they are hauling their own residential waste material acceptable to the Landfill.



This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the final passing thereof.

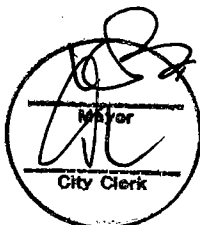

**Prohibited Waste**

- All substances listed in the Danatec Emergency Response Guidebook and/or Saskatchewan Hazardous Substances and Waste Dangerous Goods Regulations as explosives, gases, flammable liquids, flammable solids, oxidizing substances, organic peroxides, poisonous substances, infectious substances, radioactive materials, corrosive substances; including containers
- Any container, whether full or partially full or empty, in which the contents are or have been pressurized within the container with a device for slow/controlled release of the substance from the container; any aerosol or similar type container; over 1 kg.
- Propane/freon bottles or cylinders of any size
- Compressed gas/air cylinders
- Freon
- PCB's
- Automobile bodies
- Liquid, except sump and septic waste
- Electroplating products
- Unwashed plastic or metal chemical containers
- Fuel tanks including automotive and storage unless steamed and cut in half
- Petroleum remains or by-products (except soil to be recycled)
- Remains or products of slaughter house operations
- Concrete with rebar protruding more than 6 inches
- Bulk quantity concrete powder/any powder substance; unless proven to be a non-hazardous/dangerous substance
- Pipe or tubing of any type unless it is cut into 4 foot lengths
- Oilfield waste: Any unwanted substance (by the generator) or mixture of substances that results from the construction, operation or reclamation of a well site, oil and gas battery, gas plant, compressor station, crude oil terminal, pipeline, gas gathering system, heavy oil site, oil sands site, or related facility. This includes HydroVac material.
- Bentonite
- Ammunition Casings
- Chemicals of any kind
- Herbicide/pesticide containers
- Computers/Electronics – Deliver to Bea Fisher
- All cardboard – Deliver to Bea Fisher
- Waste Oil – 5 gallons or more
- Dead cows, pigs, and horses – Contact Northern Alberta Renderers
- Uncoated/unwrapped metal cable
- Uncoated/unwrapped metal wire; rolled and tied
- Any material not listed as permitted is prohibited pending prior arrangement with the Landfill Foreman. Landfill staff will refuse the disposal of any unknown substance that is deemed to be potentially hazardous to the environment.

REGULATION "B", PURSUANT TO  
PART 2 CONTROL SEC. 10  
OF BYLAW NO. 25-86

**Recycled A. Unload at metal stockpile; (Area #8)**

- Uncoated/unwrapped metal pipe; maximum length 4 feet
- Scrap iron/metal objects; maximum length 4 feet
- Rebar; maximum length 4 feet
- Metal Household furniture
- Chain link/mesh metal fence; rolled and tied; unload to separate area adjacent to metal stockpile

**Recycled B. Unload at metal stockpile; (Area #8)**

- White Goods; must have capacitors, CFC/Freon, ballast, and Mercury switches removed

**Recycled C. Unload at designated location: stack neatly on pallet**

- Batteries

**Recycled D. Unload as directed; to be farmed and treated; prior approval required**

- Soil Containing Hydrocarbons
- Soil Containing Sulphur

**Recycled E. Unload at tubskids provided for Paint Recycling**

- Waste oil-based and latex paint in original container. Service will be offered from April 1 to October 31 of every year.

**Recycled F. Unload; Stack neatly at tire area (Area #4)**

- Tires

**Recycled G. Unload at used oil tank area**

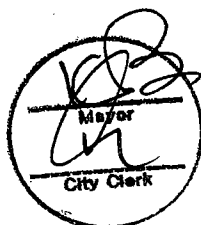
- Waste oil; dump into the waste oil tank; Oil contaminated with Glycol will not be accepted. Limit of 5 gallons maximum for disposal.
- Waste glycol; dump into the waste glycol tank; Please keep oil and glycol separate for proper disposal. Limit of 5 gallons maximum for disposal. A fee will be charged to dispose of waste glycol.
- Oil containers (maximum size 5 gallons/22.7 litres). 5 gallon pails must have lids removed.
- Oil filters. 5 maximum.

**Recycled H. Unload at Concrete/Asphalt Recycle Stockpile**

- Concrete/asphalt with absolute minimum of any other material attached or adhered to it.
- Concrete of size 2 ft. X 2 ft. X 6 ft. or less. Any exposed rebar must be 6 inches in length or less.
- Rock
- Asphalt
- Bricks
- Concrete with rebar protruding less than 6 inches
- Liquid Concrete (dump manageable size)
- Cement Building Blocks

REGULATION "C", PURSUANT TO  
PART 2 CONTROL SEC. 10  
OF BYLAW NO. 25-86

Landfilled A. Unload as directed at pit (Area #1); spread, crush, compact and eventually to be covered with soil

- All household type garbage not listed as prohibited or designated to be landfilled or recycled at an alternate location
- Straw
- Wood products
- Non-metal household furniture
- Stucco
- Glass; as alternate recycling is encouraged
- Bulk quantity concrete powder/any powder substance; if proven to be a non-hazardous dangerous substance.
- Yard and garden vegetation waste; as alternate composting in encouraged
- Gypsum wall board
- Trees; tree branches
- Fibreglass insulation
- Shingles and asphalt roofing material

Landfilled B. Unload as directed at pit (Area #1); Compactor operator will dig a hole in the garbage; Hand place; Cover with garbage immediately

- Empty paper bags originally containing concrete, bentonite, or other powder with silica as an ingredient. Must be in sealed containers or plastic bags.

Landfilled C. Unload as directed at pit (Area #1); Cover with garbage immediately

- Spent lime; by special permission/arrangements
- Dead small animals (ie; cats and dogs)

Landfilled D. Unload as directed; Cover with soil immediately

- Asbestos containing products

Requires pre-approval of the Landfill Foreman by submitting an *Application For Disposal of Contaminated Soil/Hazardous Waste*. Must be delivered in sealed containers, hand placed in a designated separate burial area, and covered immediately. Requires a hazardous waste manifest. The generator is responsible for all costs.

Landfilled E. Unload as directed

- Concrete/asphalt that does not meet recycle specifications

Landfilled F. Unload as directed; To be used as fill material or for berm construction

- Clean fill
- Street sweepings

**NOTE:** Any fill brought to the landfill with concrete pieces in it will be assessed the per mass fee for disposal of concrete.

Landfilled G. Unload in Septage Receiving Facility

- Sump and septic waste; inspection required; dumping and waste manifest must be provided.
